

**Shayla:** How may I know there is a God?

**Meforshim:**

Nature itself should lead us to believe that there is a supernatural guiding Force - a Mind behind it all.<sup>1</sup> However, we can also know God exists by seeing the miraculous works He does in and through His children.<sup>2</sup>

We can further know God exists by witnessing the prayers that He answers.<sup>3</sup> We can choose whether or not to believe the witnesses to the life of Christ and the present day witnesses who testify to changed lives<sup>4</sup>, but either way, we must be willing to live with the consequences of our belief choices.

Fully 25% of the Bible is prophetic in nature. All the fulfilled prophecies of the Bible should lend credence to its testimony. If it has been right about so many other things, would it not be reasonable to think it would be right about the existence of God? Besides, who else but a Person who lives outside of time could be so phenomenally correct about the future?<sup>5</sup>

Most of all, we can see God the Father when we look deeply into the life of Jesus of Nazareth. After all, He came to introduce us to God.<sup>6</sup>

However, in the end, it is those that are drawn by the voice of the Holy Spirit who will believe. If a person refuses to believe in the existence of God, they can rightly be considered a fool.<sup>7</sup>
